Letter from the Founder

Dear Community Partners,

As a late-diagnosed Autistic and ADHD mother raising one Autistic learner and one ADHD learner, and as the spouse of an ADHDer, I understand both personally and professionally how important it is for ADHD support to reflect the whole person.

As awareness and understanding of ADHD continue to grow, one essential part of the conversation is too often overlooked: intersectionality.

Black individuals with ADHD may navigate the combined impact of ableism, racism, cultural misunderstanding, delayed identification, misdiagnosis, disciplinary responses to perceived “behavior,” and limited access to culturally responsive, affirming support. These experiences can affect every stage of the journey, from recognizing possible ADHD and accessing an evaluation to receiving meaningful support at home, in school, in therapeutic settings, in relationships, and throughout the community.

I created **The Black ADHD Experience Conference** because Black ADHDers, families, caregivers, educators, clinicians, advocates, and community members deserve a space where these realities are not treated as an afterthought. They deserve conversations that center culture, identity, lived experience, access, and dignity.

This first-of-its-kind conference will bring these conversations together in an intentionally Black-centered, culturally responsive, neuroaffirming, and anti-ableist space. Our goal is to move beyond one-size-fits-all approaches and explore what meaningful support can look like across education, mental health, relationships, parenting, family life, and community care.

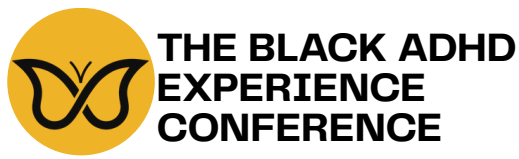

Conference Overview

The Black ADHD Experience Conference is a first-of-its-kind virtual conference created to center the lived experiences, needs, and strengths of Black individuals with ADHD across the lifespan.

Taking place **October 2–4, 2026**, the conference will bring together Black ADHDers, parents and caregivers, educators, mental health professionals, advocates, service providers, and community members for three days of culturally responsive, neuroaffirming, and anti-ableist learning and connection.

The conference was developed in response to a critical gap in many ADHD conversations: the limited attention given to intersectionality. Black individuals with ADHD may experience delayed identification, misdiagnosis, racialized interpretations of behavior, disproportionate discipline, barriers to care, and support approaches that do not fully consider culture, identity, family, community, or lived experience.

Through presentations, panels, and community-centered discussions, attendees will explore how ADHD can affect education, mental health, relationships, parenting, family life, and access to support. Sessions will emphasize practical strategies, lived experience, advocacy, and approaches that move beyond compliance and deficit-based thinking.

Conference Focus Areas

The conference will include three primary tracks:

Education, IEPs, 504 Plans, and Advocacy

Supporting Black ADHD learners through culturally responsive and neuroaffirming educational practices, meaningful accommodations, effective advocacy, and a deeper understanding of how race and disability influence school experiences.

Mental Health and Wellness

Exploring diagnosis, misdiagnosis, masking, burnout, emotional regulation, trauma, identity, access to affirming care, and the importance of culturally responsive mental health support.

Relationships, Parenting, and Family Life

Addressing the impact of ADHD within couples, parenting, caregiving, family relationships, communication, household responsibilities, and intergenerational experiences.

Sponsorship Guidelines

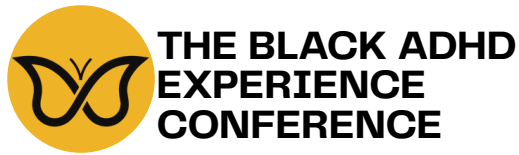
To protect the integrity of the conference and the attendee experience, all sponsorships and promotional materials are subject to the following guidelines:

- Sponsor materials must align with the conference's culturally responsive, neuroaffirming, and anti-ableist values.
- All advertisements, resources, videos, and promotional materials require approval.
- Sponsorship does not represent an endorsement of every product or service offered by the sponsor.
- Materials promoting harmful, discriminatory, compliance-based, or cure-oriented practices may be declined.
- Logos and promotional materials must be submitted by the stated deadline.
- Sponsorship payments are nonrefundable after benefits or promotional services have begun.
- Presenting Sponsor availability may be limited.
- Competitor exclusivity is not included unless specifically negotiated in writing.

Sponsor Deliverables and Deadlines

Sponsors must submit the following materials by the deadlines provided in their sponsorship agreement:

Sponsorship Payment and Confirmation

To reserve a sponsorship opportunity for **The Black ADHD Experience Conference**, sponsors must submit a completed sponsorship agreement and payment by the stated deadline.

Payment Process

Payment may be submitted through the approved electronic payment method listed on the invoice. Checks may also be accepted when arranged in advance and should be made payable to:

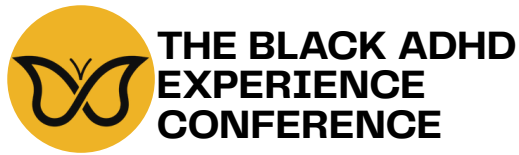

Payment Deadline

Full payment is due by **September 18, 2026**, to ensure inclusion in conference promotional materials, the digital program, sponsor graphics, and other applicable benefits.

Sponsors who commit after a promotional or publication deadline may still be accepted; however, certain benefits may no longer be available.



Payment Plans

Payment plans may be available for Advocacy and Presenting Sponsors upon request and approval.

- **50% deposit** due when the sponsorship agreement is signed
- **Remaining balance** due by **September 18, 2026**

The sponsorship is not considered fully confirmed until the initial payment has been received. All balances must be paid before the conference unless a separate written agreement has been approved.

Refund and Cancellation Policy

Sponsorship payments are nonrefundable once promotional benefits, advertising placement, resource distribution, registrations, or other sponsor services have begun.

If a sponsor cancels before benefits have been provided, any refund or credit will be determined by the conference organizer based on completed work and expenses already incurred.

If the conference is canceled by the organizer, sponsors will be offered a refund, credit, or another mutually agreed-upon option.

Tax Information
